Career Counseling/Advising:

Career advising is available to discuss any career-related issues with Career Center Staff. The first step in the process is to meet with a staff member on a walk-in basis. This meeting would consist of a 10-15 minute meeting offering brief advising. Walk-in hours are 8 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Monday through Friday in Baylis Hall.

Career Center Events/Workshops:

Resume
