REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STUDENTS

- **All** new students **must** have had a physical exam within the past year of enrolling at Maritime completed by your healthcare provider. Cadets need to have the 719K completed.
- **All** students **must** have had a tuberculosis screening within six months of entry into Maritime.
- All new students must also provide immunity to measles, mumps and rubella (MMR).
- Blood titers are necessary if medical condition or religious beliefs prohibit immunization.

REQUIREMENTS (CON'T)

- If your religion prevents you from identifying your immune status you **must** submit a written request for a waiver with documentation of held beliefs. If you lack documentation of immunity you **may** be excluded from campus in the case of a measles, mumps or rubella outbreak.
