M Academic Sessions

-  **Engineering** - Discover why Maritime College is one of the nation's top engineering schools. Our ABET accredited engineering programs include: Naval Architecture and Electrical, Facilities, Marine, and Mechanical Engineering.
-  **Global Business and Transportation** - Learn how our Global Business and Transportation program prepares students for the world of commerce and shipping.
-  **Marine Environmental Science** - Learn more about our concentrations in marine biology and oceanography/meteorology and discover the diverse career opportunities this hands-on academic program provides students.
-  **Marine Technology Small Vessel Operation (AAS)** - The associate's degree program provides a strong general education component coupled with professional training for the limited tonnage U.S. Coast Guard license.
-  **Marine Operations & Marine Transportation** - Explore our Marine Transportation department which includes highly specialized programs that focus on management, international business, transportation, logistics, and vessel operations. This session will also include an overview of the deck licensing sequence.
