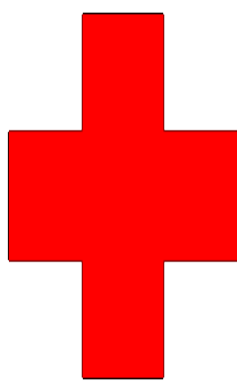

CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers and Certification Course



- The CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer class is designed for the nurse, lifeguard, flight attendant, firefighter, law enforcement specialist, EMS specialist, part of a business or industry response-team, or anyone else with a job-related duty to respond in an emergency, this course was created with you in mind. According to the American Red Cross website, through lectures, videos, hands-on skills training and a participants' manual, you'll learn how to:
- Recognize and respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies
- Perform two-rescuer CPR
- Use body substance isolation precautions to prevent disease transmission
- Utilize a pocket mask and a bag valve mask when performing CPR, and use an AED on a victim of sudden cardiac arrest
