Campus Safety Escorts

The University Police Department is committed to keeping the SUNY Maritime Community a safe and secure place for all of our students, faculty and staff. In meeting its goal of promoting safety and security, University Police will provide escort services to members of our community.

Anyone who feels uncomfortable walking to their vehicle or between facilities in the evening, should contact University Police at 718-409-7311 (ext. 7311 if calling from an on-campus phone), for a walking escort to their vehicle or on-campus residence.

When requesting an escort, you will need to provide your name and location to the dispatcher so that an officer can arrive at your location in a timely manner.

Please keep in mind that response time may be delayed by campus incidents or emergencies and that officers cannot provide escorts to off-campus locations.

This service is available 24-hours a day, seven days a week.

University Police officers work to maintain a safe environment for students, faculty, and staff, through crime prevention and safety awareness. The Campus Safety Escort is designed to enhance your safety on campus if you must walk alone. The primary goal is to enable you to travel from point to point on campus with a greater sense of safety and security.
