

Course Registration Restrictions and Reserved Seating – SPRING 2017

While SUNY Maritime College strives to have seats available for all students seeking to take courses, the college must restrict/reserve seats in certain courses for students close to graduation or in specific programs as these courses may cause a greater delay/impact in their studies. Below is a listing of these courses for Spring 2017 registration. On **Monday, November 21**st (after all student groups have had the opportunity to register for classes), the restrictions and reserved seatings will be removed and all students will be eligible to register for the courses (if seats are still available).

Course Registration Restrictions

A Course Registration Restriction means that certain groups are being given *priority* registration into a specific course before others. The courses below will be temporarily restricted to the group(s) indicated until all have had the opportunity to register.

<u>Note:</u> If you attempt to register for a course with a temporary restriction on in which you do not meet, you will receive one of the following error messages preventing your registration depending on what type of restriction is placed on the course; "*Program Restriction*" or "*Class Restriction*."

Course Reserved Seating

Reserved seating in a course means that there are a certain amount of seats designated for general population in each section and a certain amount of seats *reserved* for a specific group(s) of students. Once the seats available to general student population have filled, only those that are in the reserved seating group will be eligible to register. The following courses will have some reserved seating for the group(s) specified.

<u>Note:</u> If you attempt to register for a course with reserved seating that no longer has seats available for general student population, an error message preventing your registration of "*Reserved Closed*" will appear. This message means you will not be able to register for the course at that time.
