**Title: Engineering Electives**

**This policy describes courses that are permissible as *Engineering Electives* in Bachelor of Engineering degree programs at Maritime College. It supersedes Policy 06-01, which is hereby retracted.**

Cadets and students in B.E. programs and their Engineering Department advisors who are assisting in the selection of an "Engineering Elective" shall be guided by the Curriculum Sheet documentation for their catalog year. Current and past curriculum documentation is maintained on the Maritime College website. As prerequisites for Engineering courses are subject to change periodically by the department, an evaluation of a student's ability to take a given course may be necessary.

As a general rule, cadets and students may select Engineering courses offered at the 3xx, 4xx, or 6xx level for which they have the necessary pre-requisites and which are not required by their major program of study.

Courses offered by other departments that are pre-approved as Engineering Electives are listed in the Curriculum Sheet documentation. Other courses at the college may be approved as Engineering Electives at the discretion of the Engineering department chair.

Engine License courses Engr 503, Engr 504 and Engr 54x may be available as electives to Intern students or Deck cadets whose degree program does not require them. Availability is at the discretion of the Engineering department and requires a prerequisite override approved by the Vice-Chair of Engineering and signed by the Chair of Engineering. Permission will be contingent on available space, and academic prerequisites will be enforced.
