- Investigate and document accidents, injuries, and unsafe workplace conditions and practices.
- Prepare incident reports and update all applicable databases and spreadsheets to maintain accurate records.
- Develop and implement solutions to mitigate identified workplace safety hazards.
- Assist department managers in preparing written appeals for occupational health, safety, and environmental violations.
- Maintain a comprehensive understanding of Workers' Compensation Law and OSHA recordkeeping guidelines.
- Provide leadership and education in zero-incident safety culture and assume personal accountability and responsibility for safe work practices in all operations.
