M Academic Sessions

§ **Engineering** - Discover why Maritime College is one of the nation's top engineering schools. Our ABET accredited engineering programs include: Naval Architecture and Electrical, Facilities, Marine, and Mechanical Engineering.

§ **Global Business and Transportation** - Learn how our Global Business and Transportation program prepares students for the world of commerce and shipping.

§ **Marine Environmental Science** - Learn more about our concentrations in marine biology and oceanography/meteorology and discover the diverse career opportunities this hands-on academic program provides students.

§ **Marine Technology Small Vessel Operation (AAS)** - The associate's degree program provides a strong general education component coupled with professional training for the limited tonnage U.S. Coast Guard license.

§ **Marine Operations & Marine Transportation** - Explore our Marine Transportation department which includes highly specialized programs that focus on management, international business, transportation, logistics, and vessel operations.
