

GRADUATION AND SEMESTER HONORS

SEMESTER HONORS:

Semester honors are awarded for **undergraduate** students only. In a given semester, the student must have earned a minimum of 14 credits with a semester GPA as follows:

• Admiral's List semester GPA rounding to at least 3.50 (i.e., $GPA \ge 3.495$).

• **Dean's List** semester GPA rounding to at least 3.00 (i.e., $2.995 \le GPA \le 3.494$).

GRADUATION HONORS:

Students may be awarded cumulative GPA based honors at graduation. The indices are as follows:

Undergraduate Students

- **Valedictorian** is the undergraduate student having earned a bachelor's degree with the highest GPA closest to 4.000 and at least 60 credits earned at Maritime College
- Salutatorian is the undergraduate student having earned a bachelor's degree with the next highest GPA and at least 60 credits earned at Maritime College
- Summa Cum Laude is for a cumulative GPA rounding to at least 3.75 (i.e., \geq 3.745).
- Magna Cum Laude is for a cumulative GPA rounding to at least 3.50 (i.e., \geq 3.495).
- Cum Laude is for a cumulative GPA rounding to at least 3.00 (i.e., ≥ 2.995)

Graduate Students

• With Honors is for a cumulative GPA rounding to at least 3.75 (i.e., $GPA \ge 3.745$).
