



Visitor, Guest, Service and Vendor Information

All visitors are reminded that SUNY Maritime College is an educational institution. Please respect all rules and regulations, and maintain a good example for our students as they pursue their educational endeavors. No solicitation permitted.

All visitors are subject to an identification check, and their motor vehicles are subject to inspection and search. All visitors age 16 and older **MUST** provide valid photo identification such as: a valid driver's license, passport, or school ID (must be school-age). Each individual, age 16 and older, must present their own form of identification. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Guest and Visitor Parking Permits are available through the University Police Department at the SUNY Maritime Campus entrance. A visitor or guest is defined as a person who is not a registered student, an employee of SUNY Maritime College, or an employee of an on-campus affiliate. SUNY Maritime College, when conditions permit, may provide visitors who engage in walking, jogging, bicycling, etc. access to the campus grounds. In order to accommodate more efficient credential review for access onto the campus, you may request a campus visitor access ID card.

Rules of the Road: Bicycling

Bicyclists must obey these rules and all traffic laws. Failure to do so is a traffic infraction and could result in fines for adults and Family Court action for children.

- Stop at red lights, stop signs and before entering a roadway
- Do not wear earphones plugged into an electronic device while riding a bicycle
- Children up to 14 years of age must wear bicycle helmets; child passengers up to age four must ride in secure safety seats
- Report any bicycle accident in which a person is killed or seriously injured to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles within 10 days
- Ensure the bicycle has appropriate equipment as required by law
- Shirt and appropriate footwear must be worn at all times

Guest Policies

- Pets must be leashed at all times
- No access to facilities or dormitories
- No pets on athletic fields or surrounding area
- Smoking restricted to designated areas
- No services available or use of facilities
- No Pier or Waterfront access
- No firearms allowed
- No BBQ or picnicking without advance approval
- No tree climbing
- No alcoholic beverages
- No feeding of animals or wildlife
- MTA prohibits photographs of the bridge
- No swimming
- No fires
- No littering
- No use of profanity
- No camping
- No urinating
- No fishing without necessary permits
- No pets in buildings
- No servicing or maintenance of vehicles
