

What to Bring

New Regimental students are required to bring the following items of clothing and equipment from home for the Indoctrination Period.

pillow pillowcase, white shoe polish (black wax) brass polish matches, one book clothes hangers (12 or more) combination lock rags & cleaning items FLAT sheets, 2 white (66" x 96") broom, dustpan, mop, bucket laundry bagT-shlaundry detergentunderblue jeans (2 pair)towershower shoestoilerunning shoes (cross country or training)ball point pens, blackwhitwriting paper/stampsclothsewing kitblachfan (Not to exceed 20")all-pblack permanent markers (3)

T-shirts; white-crew (10 or more) underwear (10 or more) towels, white (2) toilet articles hing) white gym socks (10 or more) clothes/lint brush black socks (6 pairs or more) all-purpose cleaner

A standard sized foot locker is highly recommended for storage of personal items. Dimensions not to exceed 31" L x 17" W x 15 ¼" D. Foot lockers may be purchased at the Ship's Store.

POST INDOCTRINATION - AUTHORIZED ITEMS FOR 4/C CADETS

Upon successful completion of the Indoctrination period, a Fourth Class Cadet will be allowed to have the following* in his or her room:

personal computer	printer	gym bag
telephone (one jack per room)	answering machine	
calculator	clock (clock-radio permitted)	
books	one piece of luggage	

* Those students with travel distance problems are permitted to bring these items to school at the beginning of the Indoctrination period. In this instance, storage space will be provided.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

During the Indoctrination period, smoking and the use of clocks, watches and electrical appliances are prohibited. During the academic year Fourth Class Cadets are not permitted carpeting/rugs, or any furniture other than that provided by the college.

Cadets are also reminded that CD players/stereos/iPods are an "earned" privilege for Fourth Class Cadets Incoming Fourth Class Cadets, are advised not to bring these items until instructed.
