ENGINEERING

Mechanical Engineering

Combines knowledge of basic mechanical, thermal, and electrical engineering sciences

Electrical Engineering Concentrates on the generation & distribution of electric power, and the automation & control of commercial & industrial systems

Facilities Engineering Includes components of mechanical, electrical, and industrial engineering

Naval Architecture Program emphasizing the technical and creative nature of ship design

Combines aspects of mechanical, electrical, chemical, environmental & industrial engineering

Marine Electrical & Electronic Systems (MEES) Similar to Electrical Engineering program, but students complete Deck License coursework

FINANCIAL AID



Maritime College is dedicated to assisting students meet the cost of their education. More than **79%** of Maritime College students receive financial aid. Need-based aid is available and requires completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as well as the Maritime College financial aid form. Aid includes: Federal Pell Grants, Federal Perkins Loans, Federal Stafford Student Loans, and Federal Work-Study awards and Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) grants for New York state residents. Merit-based scholarships are available to qualified students.

Cadets who are selected for the federal Student Incentive Program (SIP) pay New York State tuition rates regardless of state residence. SIP students receive a yearly stipend, complete one of the license programs at the College, and agree to serve in the U.S. Navy Reserve. Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, and Army ROTC programs are available as well as direct commissioning programs with the Navy and Coast Guard.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

We make transferring easy:

Transferring to Maritime is an easy process. Fill out an online application and send us all of your official college transcripts. (Under 15 college credits, you will need to send us your high school information). Once your



file is complete, we will notify you of our decision within two weeks. We accept up to 75 transfer credits from a two-year college and up to 90 from a four-year institution. We have established articulation agreements with Nassau Community College (CC), Suffolk CC, Westchester CC, Bronx CC and Queensborough CC among others.
