

1098T Information

As required by law, SUNY Maritime College has reported to the IRS required student billing information. Form 1098-T will report the payments made for tuition and related expenses. Reportable charges are: Student Activity Fee, College Fee, Technology Fee, Wellness Fee, Drug Testing Fee, Labs, Tuition, SST Board, SST Tuition. Student expenses for housing and meals, health insurance, health services fee, and athletic fees or any late or administrative fees for the fall, spring, and onshore summer terms are not reportable charges. Form 1098-T reports scholarships and grants awarded to students enrolled in courses at SUNY Maritime during the calendar year for which they receive academic credit.

Form 1098-T will be mailed to students legal address on file by January 31. Students can also download their 1098T via <u>Self-Service</u> (under Student>Student Account>Tax Notification.
