

## Engineering Electives

Effective: May 12, 2022

This policy describes courses that are permissible as *Engineering Electives* in Bachelor of Engineering degree programs at Maritime College. It updates and supersedes all prior policies.

Cadets and students in Bachelor of Engineering programs and their academic advisors who are assisting in the selection of an “Engineering Elective” shall be guided by the Curriculum Sheet documentation for the student’s catalog year as specified in the Banner system. Current and past curriculum documentation is maintained on the Maritime College website. As prerequisites for Engineering courses are updated periodically, an evaluation of a student’s ability to take a given course may be necessary.

Generally, Cadets and Internship option students may select any Engineering course offered at the 3xx, 4xx, or 6xx level for which they have the necessary prerequisites, and which is not required by their major program of study.

Courses offered by other departments that are pre-approved as Engineering Electives are listed in the Curriculum Sheet documentation. Other courses at the college may be approved as Engineering Electives at the discretion of the chair of the student’s home engineering department.

Engine License courses Engr 503, Engr 504 and Engr 54x may be available as electives to Intern students or Deck cadets whose degree program does not require them. Availability is at the discretion of the Engineering department and requires a registration override approved by the Vice-chair of Engineering and the chair of the student’s home engineering department. Permission will be contingent on available space, and all academic prerequisites for Engine License courses will be enforced.
