

What to Bring to INDOC/Reg program

New Regimental students are **required** to bring the following items to INDOC:

1. All the items as listed in the “Uniform Requirements Package” which must be purchased from the Ship's Store. The items will be distributed during INDOC.
2. **In addition**, the following items are **required** for INDOC:

TWIC (valid through Dec 2024) *	Running shoes (sneakers – cross country or training)
Passport (valid through Dec 2024) *	Sleeping Bag
Bath towels (quantity 2, white)	Shower shoes (flip flops)
Laundry detergent	Socks (gym, quantity 10, white)
Pillow	Socks (dress, quantity 10, black)
T-Shirts (crew neck, quantity 10)	Underwear (quantity 10)
Toiletries	

***You MUST bring your TWIC and Passport with you to INDOC.**

3. The following items are for use during the regular academic year:

Alarm Clock	Gym bag
Batteries	Hangers
Bed linens (extra sheets, flat, extra-long, white)	Shower Caddy
Calculator	Surge protector (UL approved, quantity 1)
Computer or laptop,	Trash bin
Printer (<i>optional</i>)	Desk lamp

First aid kits, cleaning supplies and fans will already be pre-staged in the dorm rooms. Please do not bring these items with you.

Cadets who travel long distances are permitted to bring the items above (for use during the academic year) with them at the beginning of INDOC.

During INDOC, tobacco/vaping and the use of clocks, watches and electrical appliances are prohibited. During the academic year, MUGs are not permitted carpeting/rugs, TV, or refrigerator, or any furniture other than that provided by the college.

Please note that students **will not be allowed** to use clocks, watches, cell phones or computers during INDOC. It is recommended that those items be left at home. **For those traveling long distance to Maritime and will not return home after the completion of INDOC, bring the items listed for INDOC and the regular Academic year. Unapproved items will be securely stored until INDOC is complete.**

What to Bring to Civilian Program

The following items are **highly recommended** for use during the regular academic year:

Room:

- Alarm clock
- Batteries
- Area rug (no more than 8 x 10)
- Bed linens (twin extra-long, any color)
- Blanket
- Pillows
- Pillowcase
- Cleaning supplies (mop, broom, dustpan, Windex™, paper towels)
- Desk lamp
- Surge protector with an external switch (UL approved)
- Hangers
- Personal Clothing
- Laundry supplies (detergent, basket, fabric softener)
- Mirror
- Refrigerator (micro-fridges are allowed)
 - Maximum size limit for fridges is 5 cubic feet per student and it must be energy efficient.
- Microwave
- Television
- Trash bin

Bathroom:

- Bath towels
- First Aid kit
- Shower caddy
- Shower curtain
- Shower shoes (flip flops)
- Toilet paper
- Toiletries

School Supplies:

- Backpack
- Gym bag
- School supplies (notebooks, pencils, erasers, white out, calculator, etc.)
- Desktop or laptop
- Printer (optional)

What NOT to Bring

Items Not Recommended (Housing Violations)

- Air Conditioners
- Amplifier or entertainment system
- Appliances with open coils, hot plates, toasters
- Bed risers/lifts
- Candles
- Carpet greater than 8' x 10' (multiple rugs/floor coverings are not approved)
- Colored light bulbs (e.g. Black lights)
- Deep fryers
- Electric blankets
- Extension cords/Multiple plug adapter without built-in surge protection
- Fireworks/Explosives
- Flammable or combustible items
- Furniture not supplied by the College must conform to California Bulletin 117 & 133. and be approved by Housing. **The only outside furniture that is authorized are computer/gaming chairs (e.g. no couches, futons, coffee tables etc.)**
- Halogen Lamps/Strobe Lights/Sun lamps/UV bulbs
- High wattage equipment
- Holiday Lights (only LED lights are approved)
- Humidifiers/Dehumidifiers greater than one gallon
- Incense of any kind/hookahs
- International converters must be surge protection type
- Lava lamps or electric novelty items
- Live holiday decorations (e.g. Christmas trees)
- More than one arm chair (45" wide max.) or does not meet Cal. Bul.117, 133
- More than one fish tank (10 gal. max.)
- More than one flag/tapestry per person (3' x 5' max). Dart boards prohibited
- More than one fridge (1.8 cu. ft. max.) per person or have more than one (2.5 cu. ft. max.) per room
- More than one poster per person (2' x 3' max.). A wall covered > 20% as determined by Housing
- Octo- lamps with plastic shades or lamp with no shade, clip on lamps, hanging lamps
- Outdoor Grills/electric grill or skillets, popcorn poppers
- Propane or compressed gas, e.g. scuba tanks, paint ball tanks, etc.
- Silly string/Holiday garland
- Space heaters
- Waterbeds, personal mattress, air mattress, exceptions determined by Housing and Health Officials
