TOTE Services is a leading U.S.-based company specializing in vessel construction management, ship management, and technical consulting. They are a critical partner to enterprise organizations and the U.S. government, providing ship management services, crewing, and top-to-bottom technical consulting for everything from cargo ships to military vessels and beyond.

Since 2015, TOTE Services has overseen the construction and management of the world's first LNG-powered container ships, activated ships to support disaster relief, and managed many MARAD vessels. In 2019, they were selected by the U.S. Department of Transportation Maritime Administration (MARAD) to serve as Vessel Construction Manager of the National Security Multi-Mission Vessel (NSMV) program. This five-ship construction program is launching the nation's first fleet of purpose-built training ships for the State Maritime Academies.

Each NSMV will feature numerous instructional spaces, a training bridge, and space for 600 cadets to train in a first-rate academic environment at sea. In addition to being a state-of-the-art training platform, each ship features modern hospital facilities, a helicopter pad, and the ability to accommodate up to 1,000 people during humanitarian missions.

As President of TOTE Services, LLC, Captain Jeff Dixon, leads a team that oversees a fleet of 27 vessels and 800 mariners, including the world's first LNG-fueled containerships, the nation's first LNG bunkering barge, and numerous Military Sealift Command (MSC) and U.S. Maritime Administration (MARAD) vessels operating around the world.

With almost 35 years in the maritime world, Dixon's experience is rich and diverse. He served 27 years of active duty with the U.S. Coast Guard and was Commander, Sector Jacksonville. Prior to being named President, Jeff was Vice President for TOTE Services Government and Commercial portfolio.

Dixon served as Vice Chair of the Maritime Sector Coordination Council and has held positions on the Board of Directors of both the National Cargo Bureau and United Seamen's Services. He is a graduate of the Coast Guard Academy in New London, CT, and holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Management and Economics and a Master's in Public Administration from the George Washington University in Washington, D.C.



Leading US Flag RORO Shipping for 35 Years

American Roll-On Roll-Off Carrier Group owns and operates the largest fleet of deep-sea roll-on roll-off (RORO) vessels in the U.S.-flag fleet. ARC is a leading voice in U.S. maritime policy and defense logistics issues, working with partners across maritime labor, Congress, U.S. Transportation Command, Maritime Administration, U.S. Coast Guard, and other like-minded stakeholders to ensure the viability of the American merchant marine and U.S.-flag fleet in international trade.

In 1990, ARC commenced its U.S.-Europe liner service starting with two ships, strengthening ARC's global reach, and paving the way for future collaborations and partnerships. During the 1990s, ARC played a vital role in carrying the preponderance of post-Cold War drawdown military cargoes, personal property, and U.S. Export-Import Bank reconstruction cargoes. In the late 1990s, ARC deepened its commitment to providing essential sealift and intermodal services to the U.S. Government through the new Maritime Security Program (MSP) and Voluntary Intermodal Sealift Agreement (VISA).

In the aftermath of 9/11, ARC expanded its service offerings with Mediterranean and Middle East charters, liner services, and multimodal services supporting Operations Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom. ARC added four vessels to its U.S.-flag fleet in 2004-2005 and demonstrated unwavering commitment to assisting the Department of Defense in its mission with operational excellence and the ability to execute complex logistical operations in challenging security environments including multiple gateways to Iraq and service to Afghanistan via the PAK-GLOC, Northern Distribution Network, and sea-air multimodal services through various hubs in Europe and the Mideast.

ARC's dedication to maintaining a robust, modern RORO fleet was on display in 2016-2022 with the acquisition of seven replacement ships for MSP, bolstering operational capabilities and allowing for enhanced flexibility to meet customer demands. Following the Russian invasion of Crimea in 2014, ARC pivoted back to the European area of operations with new services across the region. In 2015, ARC played a pivotal role in supporting "Trident Juncture," the largest NATO exercise to that point in over 13 years. During 2022, ARC carried over 25,000 pieces of U.S. military equipment in support of allied exercises and reassurance initiatives, as well as significant aid and reconstruction cargoes to support Ukraine.

Spanning its 35 years of history, ARC has invested billions of dollars in a modern fleet of U.S.-flag RORO vessels. With a renewed fleet and expanding portfolio of logistics services, ARC is poised to continue transforming the landscape of U.S. Flag Shipping for years to come. Eric P. Ebeling is President and Chief Executive Officer for American Roll-On Roll-Off Carrier (ARC) Group. His responsibilities include full P&L responsibility and oversight of strategy, commercial, operations, government relations and policy for ARC Group.

Mr. Ebeling, who joined the company in 2003, has held several positions within the group, including Chief Operating Officer; Vice President Sales & Marketing; Vice President and General Manager, Atlantic Trade; Director of Government Relations; General Manager Europe; and Operations Manager in the logistics group.

The United Seamen's Service awarded Mr. Ebeling the Admiral of the Ocean Sea (AOTOS) in 2022, the most prestigious award in the American maritime industry. In 2023, Mr. Ebeling was recognized as the honored guest and speaker by the Marine Society of the City of New York. In 2020, he received the Outstanding Friend of Seafarers award from the Seafarers International House and in 2017, he was awarded the Herb Brand Memorial Person of the Year Award by the Maritime Port Council of Greater New York/New Jersey for dedication to a strong and viable American Maritime Industry. Mr. Ebeling is also on the Board of Directors for the National Defense Transportation Association (NDTA).

Prior to joining ARC, Mr. Ebeling attended American University Washington College of Law (JD, 2001), American University School of International Service (MA, 2001), and Bowdoin College (AB, Government & English, 1998). In 2013, Mr. Ebeling completed the University of Chicago Booth School of Business Advanced Management Program (AMP). He is a member of the Maryland State Bar Association.

Mr. Ebeling resides in Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida with his wife Julia and their two daughters, Alexandra and Olivia.
