Thank you for participating in the Cadet Shipping and Internship programs! All students have the right to a work and learning environment free from harassment, discrimination, and violence. Under the [Student Bill of Rights](#), Maritime College is committed to providing options, support and assistance to all students. If you would like to report an incident that occurred during Cadet Shipping or an Internship program, please see the support and resources listed below.

**Title IX:** Federal Law ensures there is equal access to education and that gender-based violence or harassment must be addressed by the College. Students that are in programs controlled by the College, within the United States and have been subjected to gender-based violence or harassment while on campus, in an internship program or a Maritime College sponsored event or academic program have rights and responsibilities for reporting. Companies may have their own internal reporting mechanism; however, we want to ensure you are prepared to report if an incident impacts you.

**NY State Law 129B, Enough is Enough:** This law protects students with policies that define sexual misconduct and promote reduction of barriers to reporting and services. The law further protects students' rights and offers protection for identities and orientations to a higher extent. The law is applicable to any program (academic, social or maintained) sponsored at or by a New York based institution like Maritime College. You have the right to report crime to the police, report to College officials or receive services all victims are entitled to.
