

SUNY Maritime College – Campus Fishing Permit Application and Regulations

Welcome

SUNY Maritime College welcomes you to our campus. To ensure a safe, enjoyable, and orderly fishing experience for all participants, the following regulations and application procedures are in effect. These policies protect our community, facilities, and the rights of all permit holders.

Fishing Regulations

1. Eligibility and Identification


- All participants must be **at least 18 years of age**.
- A valid **Fishing Permit Badge** must be **worn and visible at all times** while fishing on campus.
- The badge must be **presented upon request** by any University Police Officer or Maritime College employee.
- Individuals without a valid badge are not permitted to fish
- Failure to present your badge upon request may result in **revocation of your fishing privileges**.

2. Authorized Fishing Areas and Hours

- Fishing is permitted **only during daylight hours (sunrise to sunset)**.
- Fishing is limited to the **campus jetty near Parking Lot #11**.
- Fishing in any other area or outside permitted hours is strictly prohibited.

3. Parking

- Fishing permit holders may park in **Parking Lot #11**, subject to space availability.



4. Event Restrictions

- Fishing privileges may be **temporarily suspended** when college events require use of campus grounds.

5. Conduct and Cleanliness

- All refuse and personal litter must be disposed of in designated receptacles or removed from campus.
- The following activities are **strictly prohibited**: barbecuing / grilling, possession of firearms, vehicle repairs, consumption of alcoholic beverages, scuba diving, swimming, and sunbathing.

6. Campus and State Compliance

- All **campus traffic regulations** and **college policies** must be observed.
- **New York State fishing laws and regulations** apply. NYS Environmental Conservation Officers may inspect any catch.

7. Liability


- The State of New York and SUNY Maritime College assume **no liability for injury, loss, or theft**.
- All permit applicants must sign a **waiver of liability** prior to receiving a fishing permit.

8. Access and Display

- Fishing Parking permits must be affixed to the rear passenger side window and visible upon campus entry and Fishing Permits must be **worn visibly** while fishing.
- Individual fishing permits may not be shared.
- **Children under 18 years of age are not permitted to fish.**

Any violation of these regulations may result in the revocation of fishing privileges.

Fishing Permit Application Instructions

SUNY Maritime College is pleased to offer a limited number of **Campus Fishing Permits** on a **first-come, first-served basis**. A total of **100 permits** will be issued for the upcoming season.

To Apply


1. **Complete the Application Form**
 - Please **print clearly** and complete all requested information.
 - Incomplete applications may delay processing.
2. **Sign the Liability Waiver**
 - Applications without a signed waiver will not be accepted.
3. **Submit Payment**
 - The permit fee is **\$100** (includes one vehicle parking permit).
 - Payment must be made by **personal check or money order** payable to:

4. **Permit Pickup**
 - Permits are available for **pickup only** at the **University Police Office**.
 - Walk-in requests will **not be accommodated**.
 - Once your application and payment are received your Fishing and Vehicle Permits will be processed.
5. **Regulation Acknowledgment**
 - A copy of the **Campus Fishing Regulations** is included. Please review carefully—compliance is mandatory.
 - Maritime College reserves the right to suspend fishing activities during campus events.
